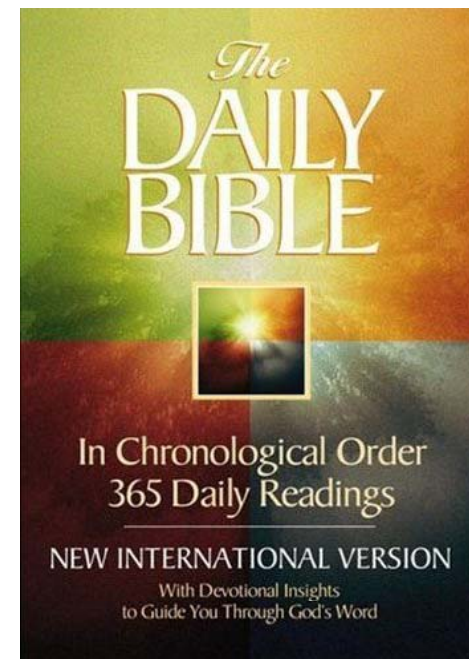

- ▶ Burnt Offerings
- ▶ Sin Offerings
- ▶ Trespass Offering
- ▶ Peace Offering
- ▶ Meat Offering
- ▶ Drink Offering
- ▶ Purification



# Burnt Offering

---

- ▶ Voluntary or Required
- ▶ What
  - ▶ Bull
  - ▶ Ram
  - ▶ Goat
  - ▶ Dove
  - ▶ Pigeon
- ▶ When
  - ▶ For specific sins
  - ▶ Daily for sins in general



# Burnt Offering (cont.)

---

## ▶ Text

- ▶ Leviticus 1:1-17, 6:8-13; Exodus 29:38-46

## ▶ How

- ▶ Person bringing offering lays hands on the head
- ▶ Priest sprinkles blood around the altar
- ▶ Entrails burned
- ▶ Meat for priests



# Sin Offering

---

- ▶ Unknown before time of Moses (Exodus 34:14)
- ▶ What
  - ▶ Depends of resources of offerer
    - ▶ Bull, goat, lamb, dove, pigeon
    - ▶ In extreme poverty,  $\frac{1}{10}$  ephah of flour
- ▶ When
  - ▶ Priests at consecration
  - ▶ Mothers at childbirth
  - ▶ Lepers when healed
  - ▶ Nazirites when unexpectedly defiled
- ▶ Why
  - ▶ Particular occasion for particular sin



# Sin Offering (cont.)

---

- ▶ Text

- ▶ Leviticus 6:24-30

- ▶ How

- ▶ Sinner lays hands on head and confesses sin

- ▶ If for whole people, elders act as representative

- ▶ High Priest sprinkles blood seven times before veil

- ▶ Some on horns of the altar

- ▶ Rest poured out at foot of altar

- ▶ Burned in entirety

- ▶ High Priest could eat some in a holy place



# Trespass Offering

---

- ▶ Not for sin in absolute, but in civil terms
  - ▶ Required restitution, plus 20%
- ▶ What
  - ▶ Ram
  - ▶ Lamb
- ▶ Text
  - ▶ Leviticus 5:14-6:7
- ▶ How
  - ▶ Blood sprinkled around altar
  - ▶ Organs burned
  - ▶ Flesh eaten by the priests



# Peace Offering

---

- ▶ What
  - ▶ Male or female cow or sheep
    - ▶ Could be blemished, if freewill offering
- ▶ When
  - ▶ At consecration of priests
  - ▶ At fulfillment of Nazirite vow
  - ▶ At any religious dedication
  - ▶ At Pentecost
  - ▶ Voluntary, as expression of gratitude to God
- ▶ Why
  - ▶ Celebrate peace between God and man



# Peace Offering (cont.)

---

## ▶ Text

- ▶ Leviticus 3:1-17, 7:11-36, 22:21-25

## ▶ How

- ▶ With bread, leavened or unleavened (eaten by the priests)
- ▶ Killed by offerer
- ▶ Blood sprinkled around base of altar
- ▶ Entrails burned
- ▶ Breast and right shoulder to priest
  - ▶ Breast called “wave offering”
  - ▶ Shoulder called “heave offering”
- ▶ Rest eaten by offerer



# Meat (or Meal) Offering

---

## ▶ What

- ▶ Bloodless offering
- ▶ Flour and frankincense
- ▶ Unleavened cakes
- ▶ Parched corn and frankincense

## ▶ Text

- ▶ Leviticus 2, 6:14-23; Numbers 15:1-16; Numbers 28, 29

## ▶ How

- ▶ Salt and oil added
- ▶ High Priest burned part on altar
- ▶ Priests ate the rest



# Meat (or Meal) Offering (con.t)

---

## ▶ If Bull

- ▶ 3/10 ephah (21 pints) of flour, plus 1/2 hin (5 pints) of oil

## ▶ If Ram

- ▶ 2/10 ephah of flour, plus 1/3 hin of oil

## ▶ If Lamb

- ▶ 1/10 ephah of flour, plus 1/4 hin of oil



# Drink Offering

---

- ▶ Given with burnt offering and peace offering
- ▶ What
  - ▶ Same amount of wine and oil
- ▶ Text
  - ▶ Exodus 29:38-46; Numbers 15:1-16, 28:7-29
- ▶ How
  - ▶ Poured out around altar



# Purification

---

- ▶ Text
  - ▶ Numbers 5:1-3
